 - Some trends for pastoral reflection; a 5-page analysis of statistical trends compiled by Fr. Walter was distributed and reviewed
- 5. Parish Status Reports (both parishes)
 - Given the steady downward trends in parishioner engagement (worship, ministry, financial support) Fr. Walter noted the need to report the status of both parishes to parishioners at some point. If the declining rates of participation is not reversed, the future of each parish could be in jeopardy. This issue is especially urgent at St. Isidore Parish.
 - Fr. Walter asked for the council's recommendations (bring to the January Meeting) on:
 - How best to present the information (how and when)
 - What suggestions could be made as to how to reverse the trend.
- 6. Pastoral issues in the development of our collaborative
 - The staff is seriously strained in trying to implement the collaborative while continuing all ongoing activities at the same high level of quality.
 - This is a year of transition; it is unclear whether all can continue as is until June.
 - At some point things will need to be done differently.
- 7. Mid-year look at the Mass schedule at St. Isidore. Looking for comments and feedback.
 - The monthly 5 p.m. Sunday Mass attendance is lower than anticipated
 - The impact on ministries was noted
 - Is this Mass fulfilling its intended purpose?
 - Should changes be made?
- 8. Pastoral Plan Update
 - A Draft will be ready for circulation in both parishes early in the new year.
